Picture this scenario: Mombasa port clears 8,000 lithium battery units monthly, but 35% get stuck in bonded warehouses due to dollar shortages. Meanwhile, informal repair shops in Kibera are doing brisk business resuscitating aging lead-acid units - a Band-Aid solution that Kenyan energy expert Wanjiku Mwangi calls "robbing Peter to pay Paul."
